The month of November may seem to be the darkest of months, as we notice how the evenings get shorter and we have to dig out our winter coats. We began this month by joyfully celebrating all the Saints of heaven, with a wonderful celebration of liturgy and fellowship (and food!) in our parish community. We then turned our attention more specifically to praying for our dead, and all those innumerable Holy Souls still waiting to reach the light of the kingdom - many who have no one to pray for them, yet each one loved and known by God "before the world was made" (Ephesians 1:4).

As we pray in particular this weekend for all the fallen in the terrible wars of the last century, we can feel overwhelmed by the suffering of the human race, as we watch those faded newsreels of so many soldiers fighting in the trenches a hundred years ago. It is good to remember, however, that God works though all the ups and downs of human history, bringing good to flourish where we can see only evil and despair. He knows each one of his children by name; for the Lord, there are no "unknown soldiers", simply his beloved friends he yearns to welcome to the glory of heaven. When we pray, God can do great things. We might feel our poor prayers can't do much, but united to the prayer of Christ, through his Church, every sincere prayer brings blessings for the living and the dead. Like the poor widow in the Gospel who "put in all she had to live on", may our prayers and our offerings be whole-hearted, trusting that the Lord can work wonders through the humble efforts of his friends. May his love shine in our hearts, to light up our parish and the whole world. God bless you.
